- **Activity type:** vocabulary, gap fill, listening for specific words.
- Time: 20 mins.
- **Note:** This is taken from U2's 1987 album "The Joshua Tree", and is a favourite at their live shows. Bono has said he was thinking of Northern Ireland when he wrote it: "in Belfast you can tell somebody's religion from what street they live on." The video was filmed on a Los Angeles hotel rooftop in homage to the Beatles's 1969 performance on the roof of the Apple building in London. Both performances were closed down by local police.

Pre-listening activity:

1) Ask the students the following questions:

Do you know the band U2? What nationality are they? What do you know about its singer, Bono?

While-listening activities:

- 2) Give each student a copy of the worksheet. Play the first part of the song students complete Exercise 1).
- 3) Play the second part of the song students complete Exercise 2).
- 4) Play the Chorus students complete Exercise 3). Note that the blanks are not given they must also identify the correct position of the missing word.
- 5) Play the next verse students complete Exercise 4).
